



Linda Ronstadt

Mike Nesmith wrote this before he joined The Monkees. Ronstadt was with her first band, The Stone Poneys, when she recorded this in 1967. It was credited to the group even though she was the only band member to appear on this. Studio musicians were brought in to back her up. When this became a hit, it prompted Ronstadt to leave The Stone Poneys to start a solo career. The Stone Poneys were 2 other guys besides Linda. Nesmith recorded this himself in 1972.

About 4 years later, when, as a solo artist, Linda needed a backing band for a tour, she hired some random musicians who were hanging around the Troubador (L.A. nightclub that was a Folk mecca in the early 70's). Included in that backing band were Glenn Frey and Don Henley, who later recruited Randy Meisner, then Bernie Leadon, and they went on to become The Eagles.

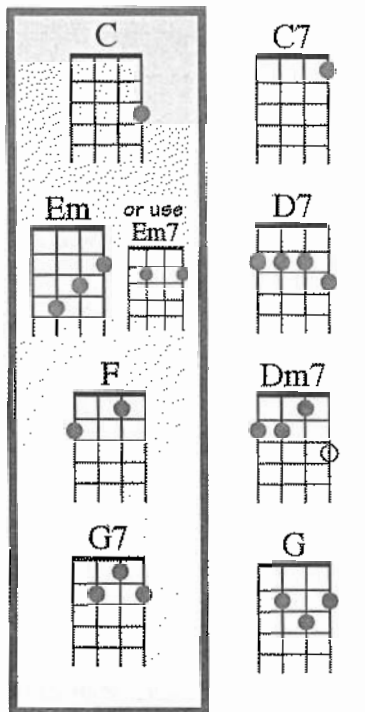
