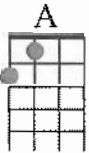
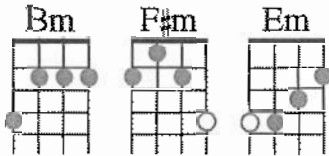
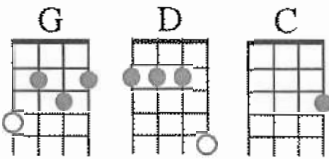


Mozambique
