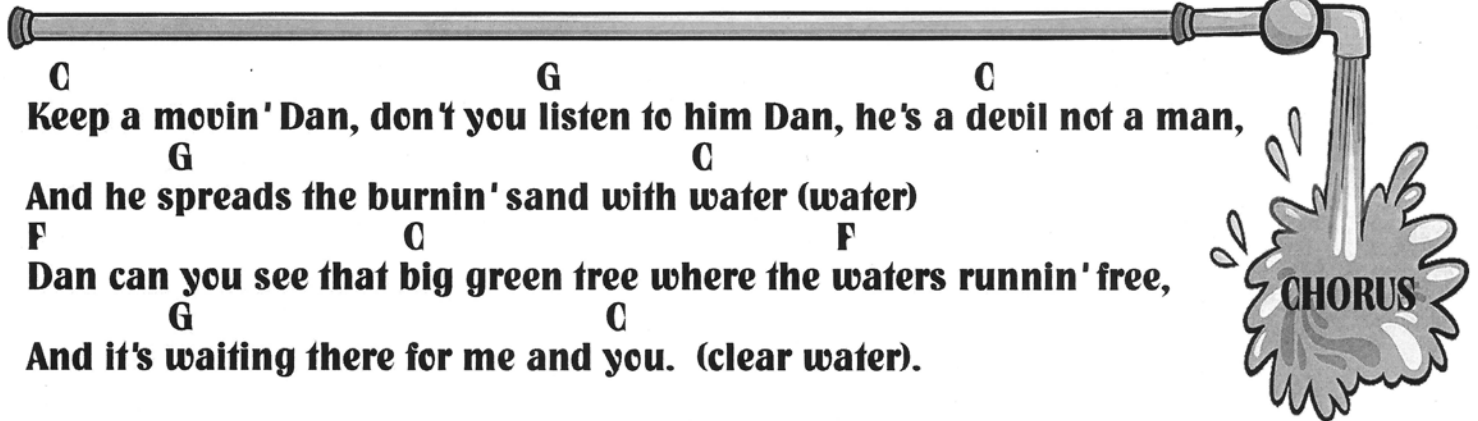


Cool Water
