This 1961 song was originally titled "Shake It Up, Baby" and recorded by *The Top Notes*. It first became a chart hit as a cover single by *The Isley Brothers* and was subsequently recorded by *The Beatles* and released on their first album: "Please Please Me." The song was also covered by *The Shangri-Las*, *The Mamas & the Papas* and *The Tremeloes*. English rock group *The Who* performed it throughout their career and Bruce Springsteen has played it live more than 350 times since 1973, usually at the end of his concerts.
