Released as a single in the U.S. in September 1965, "Yesterday" quickly topped the American charts ("Act Naturally" was the B-side of the disc). The song was also featured on the Beatles' U.S. album *Yesterday and Today*, released in June 1966. McCartney's vocal and acoustic guitar essentially made for the first solo performance of the band. In 1999, "Yesterday" was voted the No. 1 pop song of all time by MTV and Rolling Stone magazine. It remains one of the most popular songs in the history of recorded music, with more than 2,200 cover versions.
