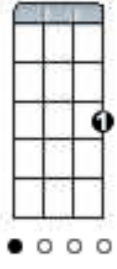
Key: C

(t) denotes tacet

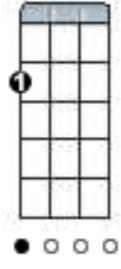
C I gave a letter to the **Am** postman,
