^G Whoa cadillac black jack couples meetin' out back ^D gonna boogie
^A Oh, get down, turn around, go to town ^{G7 F D} boot scootin' boogie

^G The dance floors hoppin' and it's hotter than the fourth of ^D July
^A I see outlaws, inlaws, crooks and straights all out makin' it shake.
^{G7 F D} Doin' the boot scootin' boogie
