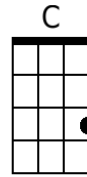

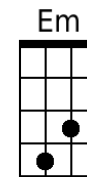

Each chord symbol 2 beats. SN= G

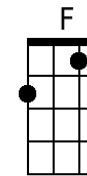

When you're alone and life is making you lonely

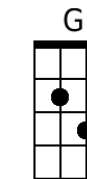


C Em F G  
You can always go ... downtown



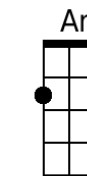
C Em F G

Seems to help, I know ... downtown



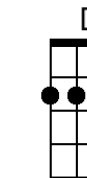
C C Am Am

Linger on the sidewalk where the neon signs are pretty



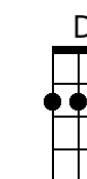

The lights are much brighter there

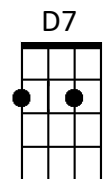
