You got me singin' the blues.

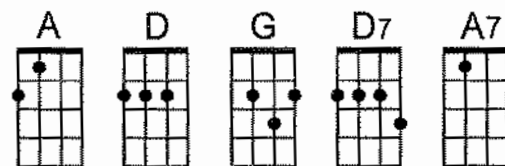
