They'd be sad, don't be bad to me.

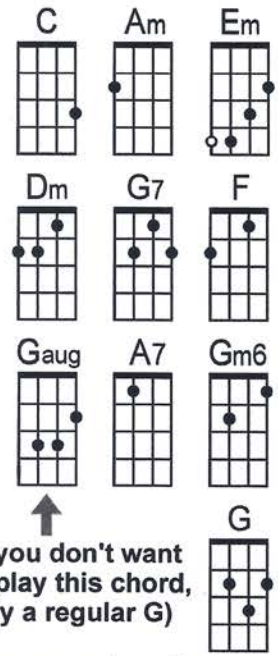
