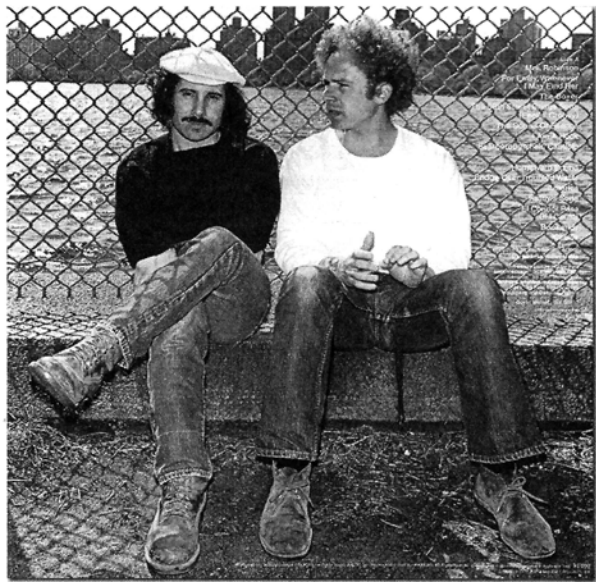


# HOMeward BOUND
