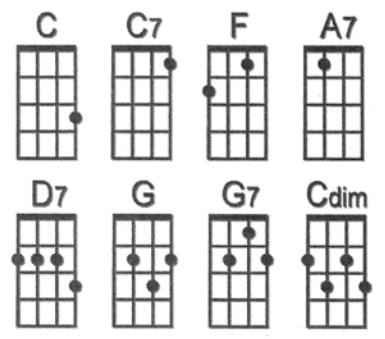


Six-Pack to Go by Hank Thompson
