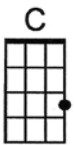
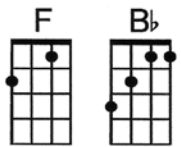
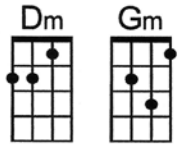


Dm Gm F Dm
