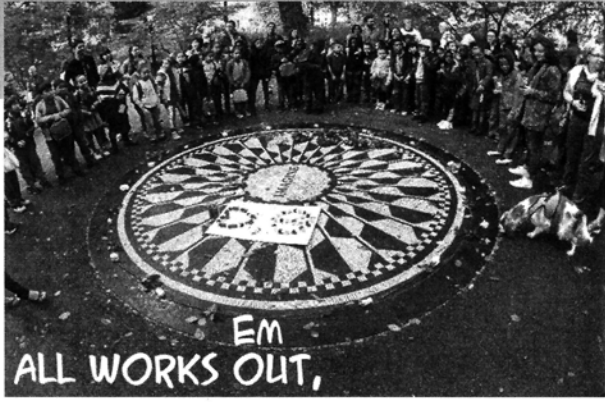

Strawberry Fields is a landscaped section in New York City's Central Park, designed by the landscape architect Bruce Kelly, dedicated to the memory of former Beatle John Lennon. It's named after the Beatles' song "Strawberry Fields Forever," which itself is named for the former Strawberry Field Children's Home in Liverpool, England, located near Lennon's childhood home.
