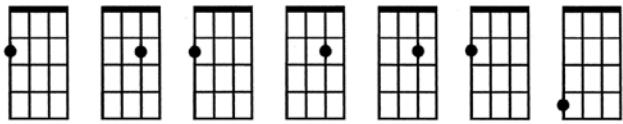


INTRO RIFF (play 2 times)

Written by Paul McCartney and originally titled "On Our Way Home", "Two of Us" was credited to Lennon-McCartney and appeared on the first *Let It Be* album. The Beatles performed a finished version of the song live at the Apple Studios in January 1969 which appeared in the *Let It Be* film. The clip was broadcast on *The Ed Sullivan Show* in March 1970 as the final appearance by the Beatles on the program.
